The course covers approximately 10 miles over outstanding countryside and this year takes you through the Park in front of Highclere Castle. Stewards will help guide you and the route will be well marked. A rosette will be presented to every rider and a photographer will be in front of the Castle.

Directions: The ride begins and ends at Crux Easton RG20 9QF. Whether travelling from north and the M4 or the south and the M3 take the A34 and turn off at Highclere and Wash Common, not Highclere Castle. This turning lies to the north of the Castle turning. Turn towards Highclere (the village) on the A343, go through the village and past the Yew Tree pub on your right, then after ½ mile take the left fork to Crux Easton. After 2 miles, turn down to the Crux Easton church. Look for the V&C signs on the road. Map attached.

Entrance fee: £25 in advance (to be received by the Tuesday prior to the ride) or £30 on the day per horse and rider.

The course will be open from 10am. Last start time will be 1pm.

Late Entries & Entries on Day to register before 12:00 noon.

Start times allocated broadly in order of arrival at the "start".

Please note: No dogs are allowed on the course.

This is a unique ride around the "Real Downton Abbey" in conjunction with other charities, so discounts for block bookings or to other rides are not available.

Please note: £2 cash deposit is taken on all number cloths - £1 is refunded and £1 contributed towards Ambulance costs.

- 6. No entries will be refunded without a medical or vet's certificate.
- 7. In the event of cancellation, the entry fee will be refunded less £3 per entry for administration costs.
- 8. The decision of the organisers on any matter shall be final.
- 9. No horse/pony may be ridden round the course more than once.
